



Your Orthotic Devices

General Information: Orthotic devices are specifically designed to control the deformity present in your feet. These prescription devices are form fitted to the exact architecture and structure of your individual feet.

Procedure:

1. After initial consultation and decision is made for orthotics to be fabricated. A separate appointment will be made for the biomechanical exam. (Measurements of the deformity on your feet)
2. Impressions of your feet are taken. These impressions are then sent to the lab for fabrication.
3. Approximately 3-4 weeks are needed for the lab to return the finished orthotics
4. You will be notified when the orthotics arrive. It will be your responsibility to determine the best time for you to pick them up. At this time, you will be instructed on the appropriate break-in period. If after the appropriate time you are still having discomfort please contact our office for an appointment to see your Physician.

Total Cost:

1. Functional Orthotics (procedure code L3020-\$ 210.00 per orthotic)
2. Office Visit for evaluation will also be billed to your insurance.
3. Impression Casts (procedure code 29799-75.00)
4. **Total Cost: \$495.00 for orthotics and casting only.** (not including a physician office visit), will be bill your insurance. If you have not met your deductible, then the allowed amount determined by your insurance will be your responsibility. If your insurance does not cover the orthotics, and you choose to pay the full amount at the time of casting, we will give you a 20% cash discount, which would bring your total cost down to \$396.00.

It is the patient's responsibility to contact your insurance company to find out if orthotics are a covered benefit under your plan. If your insurance company requires a referral, it is your responsibility to make sure they are pre-authorized and that your referral states "for casted orthotics," prior to your visit for casting.
